Project X Theatre Productions invites applicants for the following positions for X FEST 2018 (The Three Musketeers/The Three MUNSCH-keteers):

- Theatre Production Intern
- Education Outreach & Front of House Intern

These two students will be trained, mentored, and supervised by experienced theatre practitioners to provide assistance in bringing live, outdoor theatre to Kamloops and region audiences. They will obtain hands-on, practical, theatre experience working on the only outdoor theatre festival in the interior of BC.

- **Theatre Production Intern:** will work directly with the X Fest production team to assist with props, wardrobe, set construction, scenic painting, running crew, and strike.
- **Education Outreach & Front of House Intern:** will work directly with the Artistic Director to foster engagement and appreciation for the performing arts through educational opportunities and events. They will work directly with the General Manager on marketing initiatives and sponsor stewardship. They will also assist with concession sales, ticket sales, patron issues, fundraising initiatives, reporting, and volunteer coordination for the festival.
